What and Why?

The UNCSW is the principle decision-making body dedicated to gender equality and female advancement at the United Nations. Once yearly, they meet to evaluate progress, identify challenges, set standards, and formulate policies to promote gender equality and women's empowerment worldwide.

Fiat Girls in attendance learn about the serious issues facing women globally, and investigate the universal principles of human dignity, solidarity, and the common good. It is a faith journey as well as an academic one, as the girls have the opportunity to meet speakers and dignitaries, and discuss the moral ramifications of various initiatives at length in daily debriefings with guest scholars and activists.

Fiat Girls work to identify and formulate responses compatible with true social justice, giving young women the opportunity to speak, act, and witness to the Truth —both at the conference and beyond!

Tuition includes course materials, airfare, hotel, and some fees. Students cover food/spending money. Breakfast is provided.
